Congratulations. El Quds Language School has been approved for continued accreditation by the Commission on International and Trans-Regional Accreditation (CITA) for the 2007–2008 school year. Your school was awarded continued accreditation by the CITA Board of Directors on August 15, 2007 to provide education for grades K-12. The total years of education meets or exceeds the 12-year Ministry requirement.

The Commission on International and Trans-Regional Accreditation (CITA) provides systems of accreditation to promote quality schools and continuous improvement, which enhances student success. CITA is an accrediting authority both in the United States and throughout the world. It is an alliance of the largest American accrediting associations. These associations are responsible for evaluating and accrediting more than 30,000 schools in 100 countries.

To achieve accreditation, the school/center successfully completed the candidacy period, which included a self-study. A site evaluation by a team of experienced educators verified that it met the CITA quality standards. To maintain accreditation, the school/center will demonstrate that it continues to meet the quality standards and engage in an improvement process that enhances student performance. Interim reports and monitoring visits are required in the five-year accreditation cycle.

The Commission on International and Trans-Regional Accreditation grants accreditation to eligible education providers that meet its standards and requirements. CITA accreditation is separate and distinct from an Alliance Member accreditation. Education providers may promote only the accreditation(s) they actually hold.

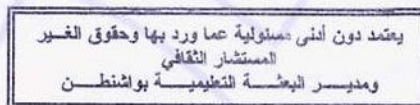
